Trophies: As our championships will be open to all brigades Station Trophies will be awarded for Senior Events and Individual Trophies will be awarded for first and second in juniors. Region Trophies and Perpetual Trophies held in District 7 will only be awarded to District 7 teams.

Refreshments: There will be a BBQ and drinks available at the ground at reasonable prices, anything else required please bring your own. Please remember NO ALCOHOL is allowed at this event.

Entry Fee: An entry fee of \$25.00 will be charged for each senior and junior team with a maximum of \$60.00 per Brigade.
